GREEN GROVE CAMPER'S LIST OF WHAT TO KNOW

AN EMAIL OR PHONE CALL WILL CONFIRM YOUR CHILD'S REGISTRATION INTO GREEN GROVE CAMP PRIOR TO THE SESSION. PAYMENT AND REGISTRATION MUST BE RECEIVED BEFORE JUNE 1.

PLEASE NOTIFY US IF YOUR CHILD WILL BE LATE SO THAT OUR STAFF IS PREPARED.

OBJECTIVES: To provide daily instruction in the Ukrainian Orthodox Faith
To provide an opportunity to become acquainted with the Ukrainian language and traditions
To provide the opportunity for Ukrainian fellowship
To experience the outdoors within the realm of a Ukrainian cultural environment

DIRECTIONS: Enter town of Wakaw on #2 highway. Turn east (at the "Nelson Beach" sign) onto 3rd Street North. Follow this road through town, across the railway tracks and to the STOP sign (about 1 mile). From the STOP sign keep going east (about another 1 mile). Turn left at the black iron gates with the Green Grove Camp Sign.

ACTIVITIES: Swimming, fishing, games, campfires, canoeing, overnight tenting, sports & hikes are all supervised activities that follow daily lessons in language, religion, faith, dancing, singing & crafts. Safety glasses have been donated and will be worn by everyone fishing. **Please bring barbless hooks only.**

For cooler, wet weather, campers can bring board games, card games & books. Everyone participates in the daily flagpole ritual & morning & evening prayers. ALL campers are expected to do their duties in the dining hall and washrooms as scheduled.

PERSONAL HYGIENE: Please impress upon your child the need for extra personal cleanliness. Being in close quarters in heat or rain makes it necessary to use the soap & toothbrush even more. Ample outdoor clothesline space is available; please bring some clothespins to help keep your clothes on the lines. Laundry CANNOT be done at camp.

PERSONAL CALLS: Children may call home COLLECT ONLY. Our camp phone number is (306) 233-4840. Phone calls should be for urgent matters only or at mealtimes (around 5:30-6:30) when kids are available. Please limit calls to 3 minutes so that the phone line is not tied up for others.

VISITATIONS: Please see the director on registration day to discuss visitation during the week.

FOOD DONATIONS: Closer to the start of camp, we will be sending out a list of non-perishable food items needed and will be requesting families to sign up to donate. This will help offset our food costs.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE: YOUTH CAMP CHURCH SERVICE & CONCERT - JULY 24 @ 9:30a.m.
We encourage all family members and friends to join the church service before the concert. There will be a luncheon served for a fee.

CHECK IN TIME: AFTERNOON OF July 24, EXACT time will be determined.

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CAMPER LIST OF WHAT TO BRING

- sleeping bag, 2-3 sheets (one for mattress protection), pillow, extra blanket
- towels (swim and bath), facecloth, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, hairbrush, comb, plastic cup for brushing teeth, & sunscreen
- T-shirts, pants, shorts, jeans, swimsuit, **sun hat, cap, water bottle**, underwear, socks, pyjamas, raincoat, rubber boots, dress shoes, running shoes, warm jacket
- Please supply your child with a set of **dress clothes** for *church services* and the *banquet*.
- Ukrainian dance costume (final concert), dancing slippers, black socks (boys). A few costumes will be available for rent (\$50.00 deposit) for the final concert. Inquire with the director during registration.
- Flashlight, pencils, notebook, pencil crayons, ball glove, laundry bag, clothespins, Ukrainian music, mosquito repellent (non-aerosol preferable), cards, board games, a plastic tote bin, reading material for before lights out.
- Optional: camera, barbless hooks, fishing gear, instrument or talent items for talent show, plastic totes for storage

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- No junk food (canteen and snacks included in registration fee), sunflower seeds, no peanut food items, electronic games (smart phones, Nintendo switch, electronics, alarm clocks, etc), jewelry or money. **No cell phones please!**
